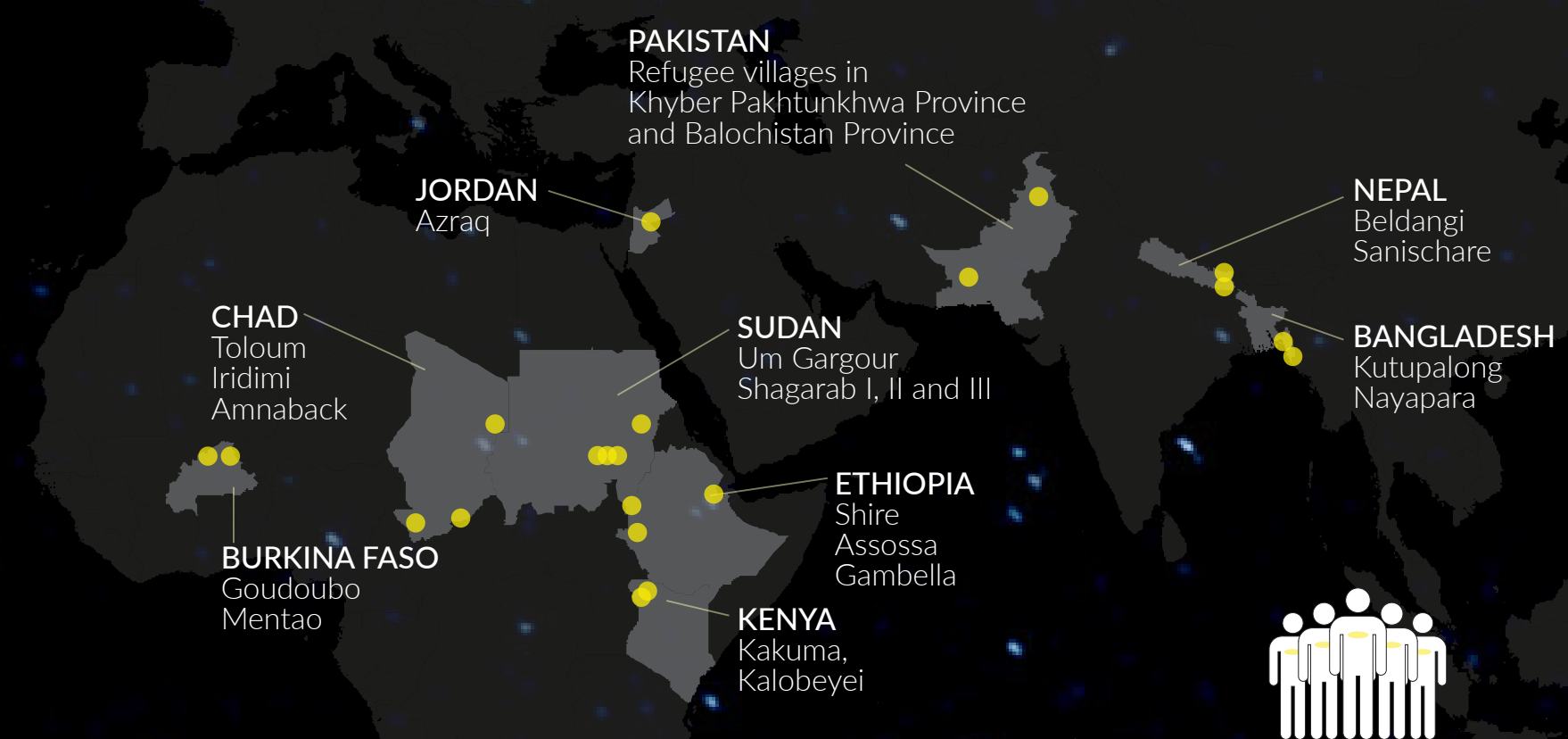


BRIGHTER LIVES FOR REFUGEES

SUSTAINABLE AND RENEWABLE ENERGY TO FOSTER REFUGEES' WELLBEING

2,524 Solar street lights installed
To foster a sense of safety in communities

15 Solar powered water pumps
Giving access to sustainable sources of drinking water

75 Biogas plants constructed
Providing clean cooking and improved waste management

411 Public facilities lit by renewable energy
Providing reliable access to services and opportunities for social life

1,944 People using solar powered internet facilities
Giving youth the ability to develop skills they can use in the future

75,240 Households provided with solar powered lanterns
Giving children and youth the ability to study at night

20,000 refugees powered by the first solar farm in a refugee camp
Giving energy to 5,000 shelters in Azraq, Jordan, while reducing 2,370 tons of CO² emissions, and saving 1.5 million USD a year in electricity costs

EDUCATION

IMPROVED ACCESS TO QUALITY EDUCATION FOR BOYS AND GIRLS IN SAFE LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

169 Refugees and their host communities trained in renewable energy mechanics
Giving these individuals the ability to repair solar equipment themselves

960 Benefited from specialized training
Giving women the capacity to leave their homes, gain skills, and participate in community activities

6,871 Students given access to computer training
Allowing youth to develop IT skills to use in future employment

80 School facilities rehabilitated or constructed
Providing more children with access to education and a safer learning environment

100,922 Children enrolled in school
Giving pupils access to education

1,096 Teachers trained
To insure the quality of education for children

5,102 Unaccompanied children received protection, assistance, and support
Insuring that vulnerable children are placed in proper care arrangements, and not left alone
